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POLICY:

1. Education: M.D. or D.O.
2. Training: Electrophysiology fellowship, or
 - A. Cardiovascular fellowship must include training in Implanting Pacemakers including Single/Dual Chamber Non-Resynchronization Devices, and
3. Documentation of:
 - A. 50 Primary Implantations of Transvenous Pacemakers
 - B. 20 Pacemaker System Revisions or Replacements
 - C. Half of Implantations Should Involve Dual-Chamber Pacemakers
 - D. 100 pacemaker follow-up visits
4. Experience:
 - A. Demonstrate current competence and evidence of the performance of at least twenty-five (25) procedures in the past 24 months
5. Proctoring:
 - A. Two (2) concurrent cases proctored
6. Current Competence:
 - A. Twenty-five (25) cases required at reappointment. If a physician has less than 25 cases documented, then the Department Chair or the Cath Lab Medical Director will perform a random retrospective review of their SJRMC cases. The review will look at any complications for recommendation of continued privileges to the Credentials Committee.
