  - A. Pediatric, Family Medicine, Neonatology and OB/GYN residency with training in performing circumcisions.

OR

- B. Successful completion of a circumcision training course or module.
- 3. Proctoring
  - A. 2 cases proctored by a currently credentialed SJRMC physician with circumcision privileges.
- 4. Current Competence:
  - A. 4 cases required every two years.
