

**Title: MAKO – Robotic Assisted Orthopedic Procedures**

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**POLICY:**

1. Education: MD, DO
2. Training:
  - A. Orthopedics
    - 1) Orthopedic Residency, and
    - 2) Current credentials to perform total joint replacement, respective to hip and/or knee request, and
    - 3) Board Certification in Orthopedic Surgery or within 5 years of completing training
3. Experience:
  - A. Successfully completed a MAKO robotic training course, including a cadaver lab, offered by the MAKO Surgical Corporation manufacturer, respective to hip and/or knee request, and
  - B. Has performed twenty (20) total replacement procedures within the past 12 months, respective to hip and/or knee request
4. A physician must actively perform MAKO procedures; if no procedures are performed every two years at reappointment:
  - A. Privileges will automatically expire and the physician must retake a MAKO robotic training course, including a cadaver lab, offered by the MAKO Surgical Corporation manufacturer, respective to hip and/or knee request.
