- 2. Education: M.D. or D.O.
- 3. Training:
  - A. Anesthesia/Pain Management:
    - 1) Anesthesia and/or Pain Management Residency, and
    - 2) Board Certified in Anesthesia and/or Pain Management, or
  - B. Orthopedic:
    - 1) Orthopedic Residency, and
    - 2) Board Certified in Orthopedics, or
  - C. Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation/Pain Management:
    - 1) Physical Medicine and Rehab Residency, and
    - 2) Board Certified in the Subspecialty of Pain Management, or
  - D. Neurology/Pain Management:
    - 1) Neurology Residency, and
    - 2) Board Certified in the Subspecialty of Pain Management

## **AND**

- E. Completion of a qualified course if this has not been a part of the curriculum of either the Residency or Fellowship, and
- F. Documentation of performance of 10 permanent implants during training or in an approved offsite qualified training center under supervision
- 4. Proctoring:
  - A. 5 cases to be proctored
