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POLICY: This procedure is core for Otolaryngology

1. Education: MD or DO

- 2. Training:
 - A. Pulmonary or Critical Care:
 - 1) The applicant must be able to demonstrate successful completion of an approved residency program in Internal Medicine, and
 - 2) Fellowship In: Pulmonary, or Critical Care, and
 - 3) Verification that the physician has obtained Percutaneous Tracheotomy training during Residency and/or Fellowship, as applicable, or through a post graduate training course approved by the Accreditation Council of Continuing Medical Education, and
- 3. Experience:
 - A. Must be able to document 2 Percutaneous Tracheotomy cases during the past 24 months.
- 4. Proctoring:
 - A. 2 cases proctored by a qualified physician if training by Percutaneous Tracheotomy course, or
 - B. 0 case proctored by a qualified physician if the physician has just completed fellowship with training in Percutaneous Tracheostomy
- 5. Current Competence:
 - A. 1 case required at reappointment every two years
