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POLICY:

1. Education: M.D. or D.O.

2. Training:
 - A. Successful completion of an ACGME or American Osteopathic Association (AOA) accredited residency program in orthopedic surgery.

and

 - A. Orthopedic residency must include training in Total Ankle Replacement, and
 - B. Successful completion of a manufacturer training course that includes didactic and skills lab, and
 - C. Proctoring of the five (5) cases

or

 - D. Fellowship in Foot and Ankle Surgery that includes training in Total Ankle Replacement

3. Current Competency:
 - A. Five (5) cases every two years at reappointment.
