Title: PROSTATIC RADIOACTIVE SEED IMPLANTING PRIVILEGE CRITERIA

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Location: Saint Joseph Regional Medical Center (SJRMC)		Department: Medical Staff Services

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POLICY:

1. Education: MD or DO

- 2. Training:
 - A. Satisfactory completion of clinical post-graduate education in Urology, of which 12 months must be in surgery, in an ACGME or AOA approved program, or
 - B. Satisfactory completion of clinical post-graduate education in radiation oncology in an ACGME or AOA-approved program.

AND

- Completion of a two-day course in ultrasound-guided permanent prostate implants at an accredited
 course, or residency training in this area with specific mention made by residency chairman
 regarding competency in this area.
- 4. These procedures must be performed by a radiation oncologist and/or an urologist, one of who must have extensive experience using transfectal ultrasonography.
