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## **POLICY:**

- 1. Education: M.D. or D.O.
- 2. Training:
  - A. Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation:
    - 1) The applicant must be able to demonstrate successful completion of an approved residency program in Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, and
    - 2) Verification that the physician has obtained Interventional Injections training during Residency or through a post graduate training course approved by the Accreditation Council of Continuing Medical Education (ACCME) or American Association of Colleges of Osteopathic Medicine (AACOM), and
- 3. Proctoring
  - A. 2 cases proctored by a currently credentialed SJRMC physician with interventional injection privileges.
- 4. Current Competence:
  - A. 2 cases required at reappointment.

\*This privilege is core for Pain Management and Anesthesia Board Certified physicians.
