

Title: Transoral Incisionless Fundoplication Procedure (TIF)

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POLICY:

To outline the privileging requirements for physicians requesting Transoral Endoscopic Fundoplication in the Treatment of Gastroesophageal Reflux Disease.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Education: M.D. or D.O.
- 2. Training:
 - a. Applicant must have completed a Gastroenterology or General Surgery residency program, and
 - b. Hold current privileges for Endoscopy procedures.
- 3. Clinical Experience
 - a. Documented evidence of Transoral Endoscopic Fundoplication training in Residency/fellowship program completed within the past two (2) years OR
 - b. Documented evidence of attendance and successful completion with certification provided by manufacturer.
- 4. Proctoring
 - a. Two cases should be proctored by manufacturer
- 5. Reappointment
 - a. The performance of 3 transoral incisionless fundoplication (TIF) procedures at reappointment.
- 6. NOTE: A credentialed Surgeon can perform solely, but a gastroenterologist will need a surgeon available only if combined repair of the hernia is to be done.
